BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Since Council approval of the **2002 update of the Student Progression Study** at its May meeting, the staff has developed two additional work products to enhance readability and usability of the report:

- 1. An interactive web-based analysis tool that calculates bachelor's degree completion probabilities based on a variety of user-designed scenarios. The tool, which has generated over 170 hits since its release on August 23, can be accessed on the Council's web site at http://www.cepri.state.fl.us.
- 2. A four-page *To the Point* summary. This prototype for future Council studies was designed to defray printing costs and increase circulation of the report.
